Best Painted Model Contest Rules

2016 Dust European Championship

(v1 - 04.04.2016)

General Rules

- 1. "Best Painted Model" contest is organized by Dustbrothers.pl and Warfactory.pl.
- 2. Each participant of Dust European Championship can attend in "Best Painted Model" contest.
- 3. The aim of the contest is to select best made and painted Dust Universe models.
- 4. Participants may apply as follows:
 - a. By sending declaration of participation to the contest together with official application to "2016 Dust European Championship"
 - b. During first day of Dust European Championship (4th of June 2016). In such a case participant must submit direct to a member of the jury or organizer

Models

- 1. Models must be prepared personally by participants.
- 2. Models should base on Dust Tactics Universe units, vehicles or heroes.
- 3. Modifications of the models are allowed and even recommended but model still should be resemble to Dust Tactics Universe.
- 4. In case of any controversy about the model final decision on admission to the contest is in hands of Jury.

Contest Categories

- 1. Main categories of the contest:
 - a. Dust Universe Hero 1 figure of the hero/officer/unique character
 - b. Dust Universe Infantry Unit any Dust units (3 up to 5 figures)
 - c. Dust Universe Vehicle any landing vehicle, vessel, plane or chopper
- 2. Participant can show one model in each main category.
- 3. Places I, II, III will be selected in each main category.
- 4. Additional contest categories:
 - a. All presented models take part in "Dust European Championship Grand Prix Award"
 - b. All presented models take part in "Vox Populi Award"

Models Presentation

- 1. All models are presented in specially prepared spot.
- 2. If participant use model during Championship then his model should be available for viewing by Jury between battles and during brakes.
- 3. Each model has dedicated ID number and card to describe model modifications and painting techniques.

Models Evaluation

- 1. Models evaluation and decision on winners of main categories will be made by Jury composed of:
 - a. Oliver Zamfirescu Dust Studio,
 - b. Paolo Parente Dust Studio,
 - c. Paweł Makuch Monstroys.
- 2. Jury awards first, second and third position in each category.

- 3. There are no strict guidelines concerning rules of models evaluation.
- 4. Jury decision based on subjective assessment of Jury members taking into account quality, attractiveness, innovative approach, composition and details of presented models.
- 5. Jury decision is final without any option to protest.

Dust European Championship Grand Prix Award by Monstroys

- 1. Grand Prix Award for Best Painted, special award for one model among all categories, is announced at the end of Championship.
- 2. Grand Prix Award evaluation and decision on winners will be made by Paweł Makuch, inspirer of the Grand Prix Award, with support of other members of Jury.
- Decision based on subjective assessment taking into account quality, attractiveness, innovative approach, composition and details of presented models.
- 4. Decision is final without any option to protest.

Vox Populi Award by Dustbrothers.pl

- 1. Special "Vox Populi Award" for best painted model is announced at the end of Championship.
- 2. Each Central Europe Dust Championship participant can take part in "Vox Populi Award" voting.
- 3. Each participant can cast one vote on any model which is submitted to the "Best Painted Model" contest.
- 4. Vote (Model ID number) has to be written on specially prepared paper sheet. All votes are collected in dedicated box for votes.
- 5. Participants of "Best Painted Model" contest also may attend in the "Vox Populi" voting, but they can't be voting for their models according to the "fair-play" principle.

6. Jury count all votes and announce the winner.

Winners Announcement

 All winners (Main Categories, Grand Prix, Vox Populi) are announced at the end of Dust European Championship in Sunday 5th of July 2016.
